The Department of Nutrition and Exercise Physiology (<https://medicine.wsu.edu/nutrition-and-exercise-physiology/>), Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine, Washington State University Health Sciences Spokane, is seeking 2 tenure-track Assistant Professors.

Duties: Teach and advise undergraduate and graduate students; conduct collaborative and/or cross-disciplinary research; pursue grant funding; provide service. Research must be in clinical- or community-based populations. One position will teach courses and conduct research in exercise science, and will direct the undergraduate exercise internship. The other will teach courses and conduct research in human nutrition.

Requirements: Both positions require an earned terminal degree (e.g., PhD). Position 1 will be in exercise physiology or related field; certification as an ACSM CEP or RCEP is required. Position 2 will be in human nutrition or related field; the Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RD/RDN) credential is required. Candidates with postdoctoral research experience preferred. Candidates without required credentials must be eligible to sit for the examination prior to the start date.
