

THE HUDDLESON AWARD 2017: Recognize research excellence—Nominate an article published in the 2017 *Journal* for the Huddleson

EVERY YEAR, THE *JOURNAL OF THE ACADEMY OF Nutrition and Dietetics* is proud to present its readers with a variety of revealing and insightful articles that expand the perimeters of nutrition science. While every article featured in this publication reflects a worthy contribution to the dietetics profession, each year there are a select number of articles whose research and content are so exceptional that they deserve to be recognized by the Academy.

The Huddleson Award, bestowed by the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Foundation, is named for Mary Pascoe Huddleson, editor of the *Journal* from 1927 to 1946. The award, which recognizes a registered dietitian nutritionist who was the lead author of an article published in the *Journal*, carries an honorarium of up to \$1,000*.

We invite you to take a few moments to consider which **research**, **practice**, or **review** articles—published in the *Journal* during the 2017 calendar year—had the greatest impact on you.

A committee of judges will review nominations and make recommendations to the Foundation. The Foundation, after

determining the winner of the Huddleson Award, will issue an official announcement.

In order for an author to be eligible for the Huddleson Award, he or she should be:

- a member of the Academy;
- a registered dietitian nutritionist; and
- the lead author.
