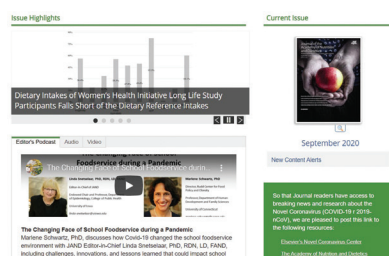
#### New Research on the Retail Marketing of Sugar Sweetened Beverages
