

JAND Reviewer Instructions: Professional Practice

Possible areas to address, as needed:

- Provide suggestions for title rewording to ensure that the title is focused and interesting.
- Provide suggestions for improving the organizational flow.
- Check that there is an introduction that includes a brief description in the first or second paragraph of what the article is about--the intent of the article, who will benefit from the information, and what they can expect to learn.
- Provide suggestions for how the authors might better highlight the relevance of the topic for food and nutrition practitioners.
- Check that adequate evidence-based information is presented to help provide a sufficiently detailed picture of the topic being addressed for the reader.
- Check for under-referencing and over-referencing.
- Critically appraise the cited literature to ensure that the paper refrains from selectively emphasizing literature that supports one position while dismissing or ignoring other literature.
- Make sure that the take home message is clear.
